# **COVID-19 Frequently Asked Questions**

#### **VACCINATIONS**

What do I need to bring to my vaccination appointment? Please bring an ID and an insurance card to your appointment. Your insurance will be charged an administrative fee, but there will be no out-of-pocket cost to you. If you do not have insurance, you may still receive a vaccine at no cost.

How much does it cost to get a vaccination? There is no charge to you personally for vaccinations. If you have insurance, Medicaid, etc. it will be billed for the administration costs. If you do not have insurance there is no charge for the vaccine or administration.

I am eligible for the vaccine but there are no appointments, what do I do? If there are no appointments available with us at Cheyenne-Laramie County Health, we encourage eligible members of the public to schedule with one of the other local providers.

Which vaccine will I receive? Laramie County has received shipments of all approved vaccines. These are not always consistently available, so you will not be able to pick your vaccine. You will be advised which vaccine you are receiving when you arrive for your vaccination. If a second dose is needed, it will be the same vaccine type as the first dose.

If I tested positive for COVID-19, do I need a vaccine? If you previously tested positive for COVID-19, it is still recommended to receive a vaccine once eligible.

### **TESTING**

Where can I be tested? Testing is currently performed in the community by most urgent care and primary care physicians. A list of testing locations can be found at the <a href="Laramie County COVID">Laramie County COVID</a>

<a href="Additionally">Additionally</a>, free at-home COVID-19 testing is available to Wyoming residents through Vault. Please visit the WDH website <a href="HERE">HERE</a> for more information.

When is testing available? Please contact the provider you will test at regarding their available times for COVID-19 testing, or utilize the at -home testing provided through the WDH for your convenience.

**How much does testing cost?** Please contact the provider you will use for testing regarding details on the cost of their COVID testing. The Vault test through the WDH is free.

How long does it take to get my results? Results are available typically 72 hours after the test. You will be notified when the results are processed and received.

How will I receive my test results? You will be notified of your result through the clinic that you were tested at. Please clarify with them at the time of your appointment how those will be communicated. Positive results will then be contact traced.

#### COMMUNITY

I am planning a community event, what do I need to do? Create your plan for hosting the event according to the current state orders, including social distancing and cleaning, and submit that to the Health Department as early as possible for approval.
