



We are hiring an Immunization Communicable Disease RN/Logistics Coordinator to join our amazing team in Cheyenne, Wyoming. The heart of public health is the community we work to protect. For Cheyenne Laramie County Public Health (CLCPH), that community is Laramie County. We live by the mission to protect, promote, and enhance community health for everyone in Laramie County.

As an Immunization Communicable Disease Clinic Nurse, you will:

- Provide patient vaccines over the life span.
- Complete communicable disease testing (i.e., vaccine titers, TB tests).
- Community outreach and education.
- Become competent in public health emergency preparedness activities.

As a Logistics Coordinator, you will:

- Orders vaccines, necessary medical supplies, proper receipt, and storage of vaccine deliveries.
- Documents vaccine inventory information and organizing vaccines within the storage units including rotating stock at least weekly and removing expired vaccine.
- Collect data for the Immunization Clinic. Ensures the data is accurate in WYIR, inventory, billing, and local reports (i.e., Board of Health data). Investigates and corrects discrepancies accordingly and seeks guidance from the Manager when unable to resolve.
- Works in collaboration with the Wyoming Department of Health Immunization Unit to ensure compliance with the program specific policies and guidelines.
- Set up temperature monitoring devices. Reading and recording storage unit temperature a minimum of two times each workday. Reading and recording storage unit temperatures from a digital data logger two times each workday. Reviewing and analyzing temperature data at least weekly for any shift in temperature trends.
- Responds to out-of-range temperatures (temp excursion) to include after-hours notification.
- Ensures staff is properly trained in vaccine handling.
- Oversees emergency preparation, including plans for ensuring safety of vaccine during emergencies. This includes appropriate handling of vaccines during a disaster or power outage.
- Assists with the organization of vaccine events both in the community and within the CLCPH office.



If you are the right person for this opportunity, you will have the following skills and experience:

- Must be licensed or eligible for licensure as a Registered Nurse (RN) in the State of Wyoming
- CPR Required
