As the Communication, Outreach & Education Coordinator, you will:

- The COE Coordinator will develop a communications team within the department and with external input to ensure cultural and linguistic appropriateness.
- Develop a communication plan guiding both internal and external communications.
- Seeks out and collaborate with representative of non-English speaking individuals/groups to ensure accessibility of materials.
- Develop and maintain an ongoing annual public health COE calendar.
- Maintain social media presence and Facebook resources to ensure appropriate COE and responses.
- Determine scope of activities for various communication tools, i.e. social media print, broadcast, etc.
- Maintain updated media contact information.
- Search out and coordinate Outreach and Education events in the community and coordinate CLCPH participation.
- With subject matter experts, develop and distribute topic information, i.e. vaccine information, environmental health specific, communicable diseases, etc. on multimedia platforms.
- Develop an evaluation and Quality Improvement process for all COE efforts.
- Develop a social medial toolkit for Cheyenne Laramie County Public Health (CLCPH).
- Coordinate education and outreach events.
- Collaborate with leadership to develop internal COE training for staff to ensure their readiness in COE activities.
- Identify external stakeholders and determine the level of effective communication and contact point.
- Work collaboratively with internal subject matter experts to identify and coordinate COE opportunities in the community.
- Collaborate with internal staff to develop educational materials including social media education posts.
- Assist with the development of COE policies for the organization.
- Will assist in response activities as a public health employee.

- Associate's degree in marketing, communications, public health or similar program and 1 year experience.
- High School Diploma or equivalent with 3 years' experience.
- Ability to effectively apply written and oral communication skills.
