

We are hiring a County Health Officer to join our amazing team in Cheyenne, Wyoming. The heart of public health is the community we work to protect. For Cheyenne Laramie County Public Health (CLCPH), that community is Laramie County. We live by the mission to protect, promote, and enhance community health for everyone in Laramie County.

The County Health Officer (CHO) provides additional support to Cheyenne Laramie County Public Health (CLCPH) and the Public Health Nursing (PHN) division in relation to public health preparedness and response. The CHO will ensure clinical and medical guidance and leadership in public health emergency matters in supporting the existing public health infrastructure within the county.

This is a PRN Contractual position.

As the County Health Officer, you will:

- Provide support and expertise to the emergency planners as needed to ensure preparedness for public health emergencies.
- Work in conjunction with the State Health Officer (SHO) and PHN division during public health emergencies and participate in meetings/conference calls with the agency or local officials as needed for the public health response.
- Meet with PHN division leader to review medical plans and contingencies, the protocols for events, the role of public health in county emergencies and other issues of concern.
- Collaborate with county officials in the development of policies that improve health outcomes.
- Monitor disease outbreaks and implement disease prevention control measures.
- Medical oversight for CLCPH programs to include signing standing orders and protocols.
- Assist CLCPH in carrying out provision of all health and sanitary laws and regulations of the state.

If you are the right person for this opportunity, you will have the following skills and experience:

- A minimum of a Nurse Practitioner, Physician's Assistant, DO or MD required.
- Knowledge of the principles and practices and interagency responsibilities involved in contemporary public health.
- Knowledge of federal and state laws and regulations governing the services and work of local public health programs.
- Knowledge of the organization and the purpose of local health departments.
- Knowledge of public information practices and techniques; practices of health service advocacy; principles and practices of determining and serving community health needs.
- Ability to effectively communicate verbally and in writing.
