



We are hiring a Ryan White Case Manager to join our amazing team in Cheyenne, Wyoming. The heart of public health is the community we work to protect. For Cheyenne Laramie County Public Health (CLCPH), that community is Laramie County. We live by the mission to protect, promote, and enhance community health for everyone in Laramie County.

As a Ryan White Case Manager, you will:

- Work in collaboration with the CLCPH Adult Health Team and WDH Communicable Disease Unit to provide case management services for HIV positive clients.
- Acts as a point of contact for the client and implements and monitors the plan of care created in conjunction with the client includes recommendations by care providers and client preferences while working within the standards defined by the Wyoming Ryan White Program.
- The Case Manager (CM) shall make initial contact with the client to determine eligibility for the Wyoming Ryan White Program and shall maintain regular contact with the client per program guidelines and as agreed upon with the client and RN in the care plan.
- The CM shall document every direct and indirect contact, including assessing the progress of implementation of the plan of care in the client's record.
- The CM shall advise the participants about available services and service providers by making referrals to service providers selected by the client. The CM will, when necessary, assist the client in gaining access to services for which the client is eligible, and which the client chooses, to include available support services such as medical, social, housing, financial, and counseling. The CM shall, with the client's permission, follow up with referral sources.
- The CM will monitor and evaluate the participant's plan of care and will review each activity outlined in the plan of care, modify the action plan or goals to accommodate the client's changing needs at regular intervals as required to Program guidelines and individual client needs.
- Participate in community functions, meetings, and outreach as appropriate.
- Demonstrate excellent communication and patient education skills required with proficiency in a variety of communication formats including verbal, written, and use of interpreter services.

If you are the right person for this opportunity, you will have the following skills and experience:

- Associate's degree in nursing or a bachelor's degree in social work, Gerontology, Psychology, Counseling or Sociology.
- A minimum of one (1) year case management experience.
- Must obtain HIV Case Management Certification within 60 days of hire.
- CPR - Required
